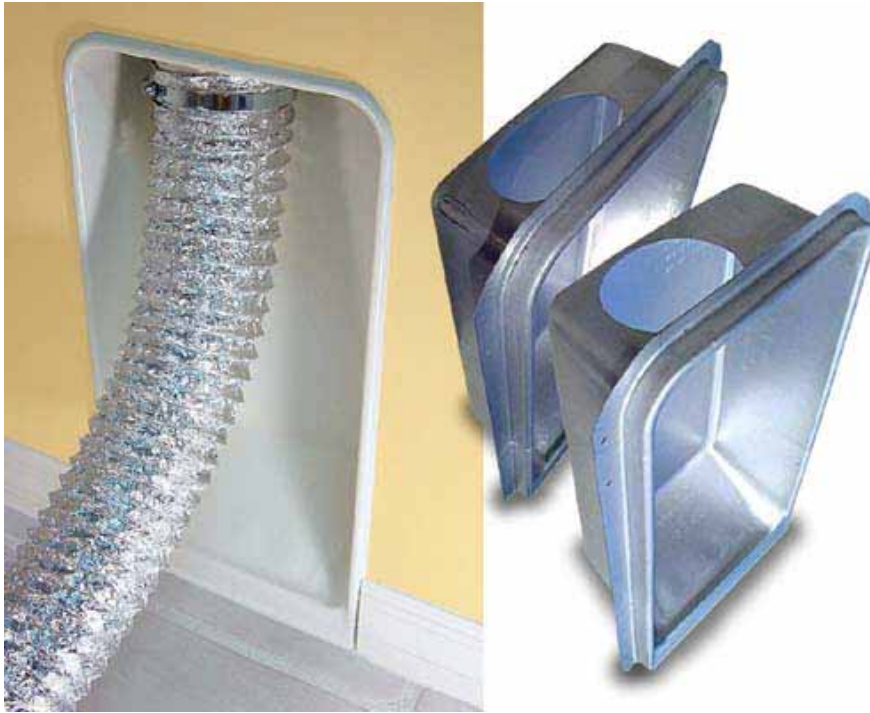

Smooth Transition

The Dryerbox™ is a better way to connect a dryer.



The Dryerbox™ is a small idea, but a good one. Very good, in fact. It's made of 22-gauge aluminized steel, drawn deep into a pan shape. It's sized to fit between wall studs, and it provides a nice clean cavity that receives the exhaust from a dryer. The device makes for a neater installation, a smoother transition from the hose to the back of the dryer, and it allows the dryer to be positioned without fear of kinking the exhaust hose. It's about time somebody came up with a piece of hardware to solve all these problems. The Dryerbox™ is available in two models. One is designed for new construction, the other is intended to be cut into an existing wall. They cost about \$20 each.
